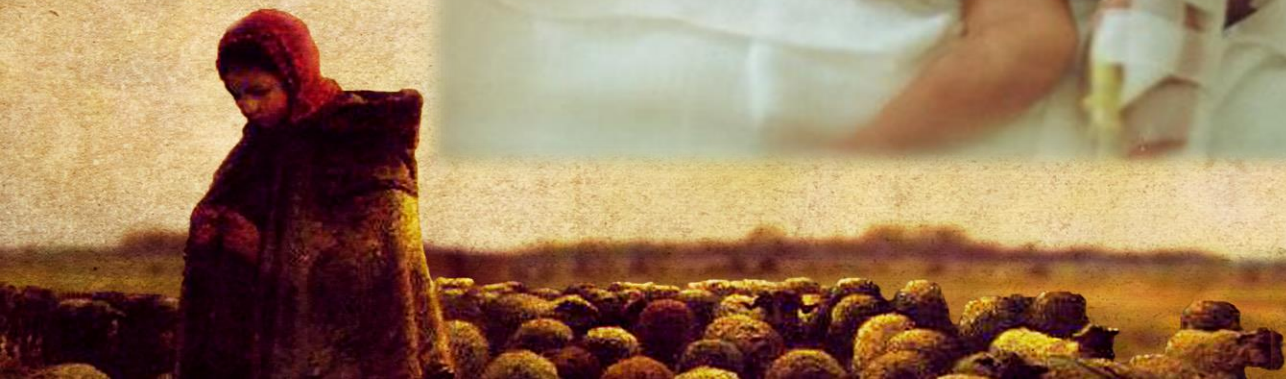


# You Are With Me


1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
