- BLAMELESS IN ALL THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD



Psalms 119:1-8

1 BLESSED ARE THOSE WHOSE WAY IS BLAMELESS, WHO WALK IN THE LAW OF THE LORD! ² BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO KEEP HIS TESTIMONIES, WHO SEEK HIM WITH THEIR WHOLE HEART, ³ WHO ALSO DO NO WRONG, **BUT WALK IN HIS WAYS!** ⁴ YOU HAVE COMMANDED YOUR PRECEPTS TO BE KEPT DILIGENTLY.

Joseph (Matthew 1:19-25)

- A JUST MAN
- UNWILLING TO PUT MARY TO SHAME
- WAS QUICKLY
 OBEDIENT
- SELF-CONTROLLED



Micah 6:8

8 HE HAS TOLD YOU, O MAN, WHAT IS GOOD;

AND WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU BUT TO DO JUSTICE, AND TO LOVE KINDNESS, AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH YOUR GOD?



- JOSEPH DIDN'T TAKE JOY IN ANOTHER'S SHAME
- MUST HAVE BELIEVED SHE WAS UNFAITHFUL
- YET HE WAS READY TO PROTECT MARY
- WAS HUMBLE IN HIS ACCEPTANCE



Simeon (Luke 2:25-35)

- RIGHTEOUS AND DEVOUT
- VISITED THE TEMPLE REGULARLY
- AWAITING THE COMFORT OF HIS PEOPLE



Psalms 130:5-6

5 I WAIT FOR THE LORD, MY SOUL WAITS, AND IN HIS WORD I HOPE;

6 MY SOUL WAITS FOR THE LORD MORE THAN WATCHMEN FOR THE MORNING, MORE THAN WATCHMEN FOR THE MORNING.



Anna (Luke 2:36-38)

- DIDN'T DEPART THE TEMPLE
- WORSHIPING WITH FASTING AND PRAYING



Psalms 27:4-5

4 ONE THING HAVE I ASKED OF THE LORD, THAT WILL I SEEK AFTER: THAT I MAY DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE, TO GAZE UPON THE BEAUTY OF THE LORD AND TO INQUIRE IN HIS TEMPLE.

5 FOR HE WILL HIDE ME IN HIS SHELTER IN THE DAY OF TROUBLE; HE WILL CONCEAL ME UNDER THE COVER OF HIS TENT; HE WILL LIFT ME HIGH UPON A ROCK.



Exodus 33:15

15 AND HE SAID TO HIM, "IF YOUR PRESENCE WILL NOT GO WITH ME, DO NOT BRING US UP FROM HERE."
