Asaph's Dilemma: Why do good things happen to bad people?

Habakkuk: "How long, Lord, must I call for help, and you will not hear? Or cry to you "violence" and you will not save?" (Habakkuk 1:2) "...Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves?" (Habakkuk 1:13)

Why does the way of the wicked prosper? Why do all the faithless live at ease?" (Jeremiah 12:1)


