
# Daniel Chapter 4

Daniel 2:47

Daniel 3:28

### God Hates Pride

#### **Proverbs 16:5**

Everyone who is arrogant in heart is an abomination to the Lord; be assured, he will not go unpunished.

Proverbs 16:18

Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall.

James 5:6a-10
